Ultralight pilot permit

Fly recreationally at an affordable cost

Privileges

After receiving your permit you will be able to pilot any ultralight aircraft in Canada during day time hours and under normal weather conditions. You can add a passenger carrying endorsement to your permit to fly your family and friends around in advanced ultralights.

Training requirements and cost break down

16 years old (training can begin at any age, students can fly solo at age 14)

You will need to fill out a self-declared medical-no examination needed you can fill it out yourself unless you have a condition listed on the medical forum.

You will require 20 hours ground school covering air regulations, navigation, meteorology, airmanship and emergency procedures.

You will require practical in air flight training.

The minimum time required for training is 10 hours with an instructor and 2 hours of solo flight training. As most students require more time to become entirely confident we advertise 15 hours of dual and 5 solo so you don't have unexpected expenses.

You will need to pass the ultralight exam and radio exam.
